It can help find and bring together people who care about you.

How does it work? What happens?



A trained coordinator will talk to you about:

coordinator\*

\*will work with you throughout Lifelong Links and listen to what you want and need.

People you want to be in touch with.

Your hopes and dreams.

Your family, friends & school.

After chatting to you the coordinator will:

- 1 Learn about people that are important to you.
- 2 See if they can find those people.
- 3 Discuss with you and your social worker if they should be invited to a meeting called a celebration event.

# How can Lifelong Links help me?



It can help you find people you have lost contact with or a family member you've not met yet.



It can help you learn more about your family history.

It can bring together people who you want in your life and who you can turn to for support as you grow up.

It can help you make fun memories with your family, like going to the park every week or having sleepovers.

It can help you safely contact the people important to you.
