  - Celebrate those tricky words with a quick cheer or high five when they're cracked.
  - Bring the story to life by acting out favourite parts using toys or everyday items.
  - Encourage your child to read short words or phrases they feel proud of. Homework will be set every Friday and should be returned the following Friday for checking.
