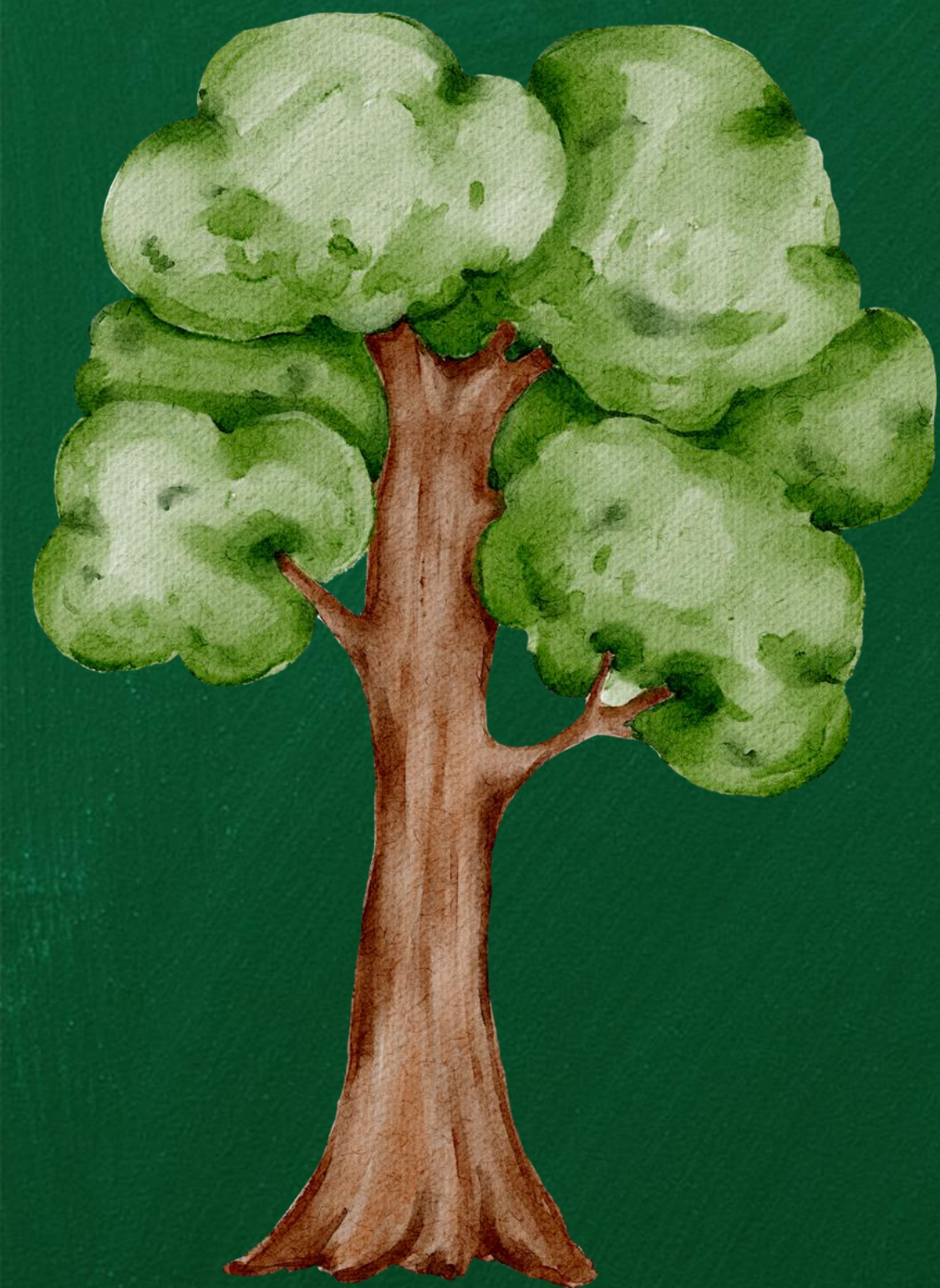

Arrival and Dismissal Procedures:



Drop Off: On the large playground (Gate 6) ready for the bell at 8.45 am.

Best ways to communicate:

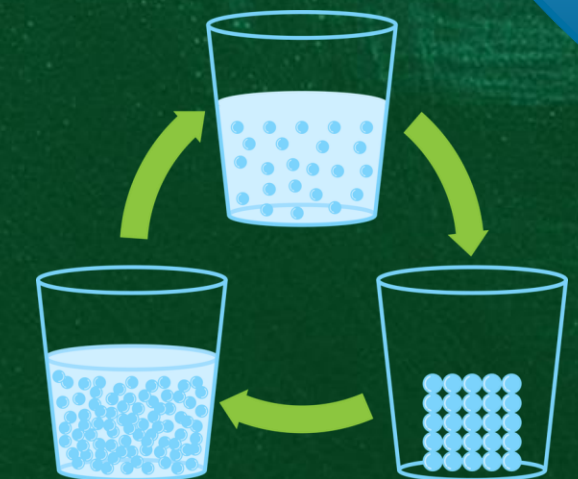
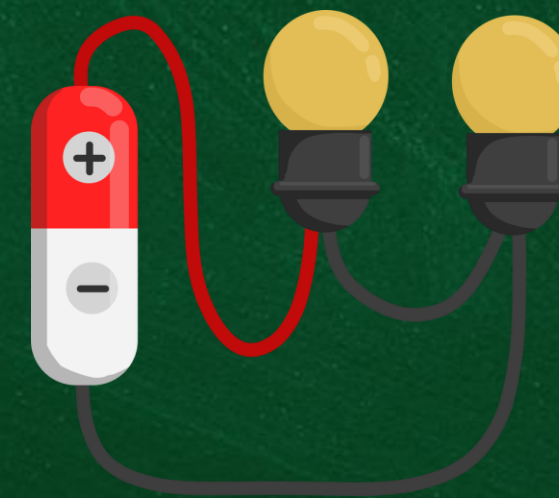
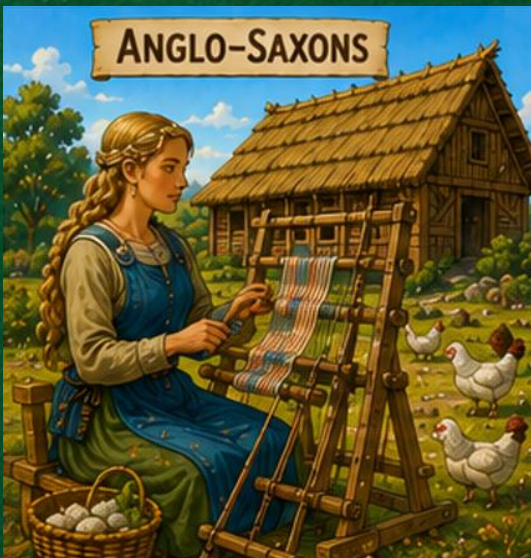
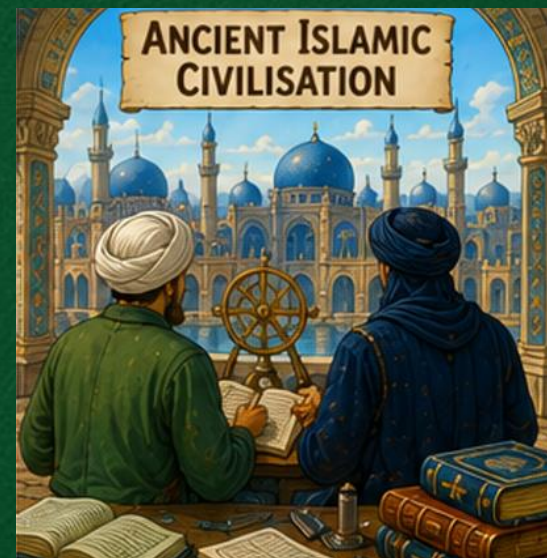
